GEBT 2024 opens today, exploring the frontiers of smart spaces

Guangzhou, 9 June 2024. The 21st Guangzhou Electrical Building Technology (GEBT) opens its doors today at the China Import and Export Fair Complex in Guangzhou. Taking place from 9 – 12 June 2024, the fair is held concurrently with Guangzhou International Lighting Exhibition (GILE), together hosting 3,383 exhibitors from 20 countries and regions, with a record-breaking total exhibition area of 260,000 sqm. In addition to the increase in scale, this year's GEBT hosts a series of forums aiming to expand the boundaries of smart technology application across different spaces.

Across halls 9.2, 12.2, and 13.2 in area B of the fairground, GEBT is presenting three new product zones showcasing a diverse range of products and solutions, covering home automation, intelligent building and smart spaces. Highlights include:
